


Welcome to the launching of the PowerSchool Parent Portal!

PowerSchool, a web-based student information system (SIS) began service for Forest Ridge School District in September 2006. It provides real-time information to all users — over the Internet. To support and facilitate partnership in learning, the system has a component named the Parent Portal. The Parent Portal can be accessed from any Windows or Mac computer with a web browser and allows parents to securely view your child's attendance, grades, school bulletin and send emails to your child's teachers directly with the use of Internet. The Parent Portal allows collaboration to improve student achievement. Up-to-date, online access to grades, homework, attendance and assignments makes it easier for parents, teachers and students to accurately monitor, identify and accelerate student progress.
